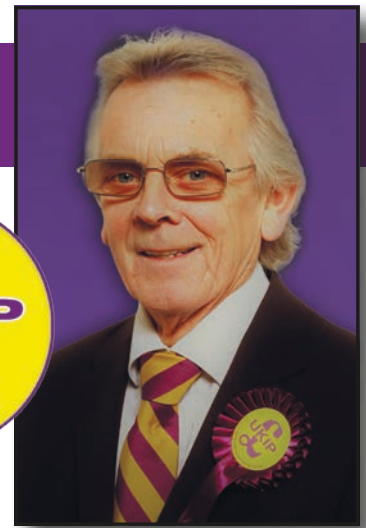


Your UKIP Candidate for...
